Thank you for your kind and considerate donation of the XM52 Smoke Generator Subsystem for the Huey. Support of this kind is essential to the preservation of our history and if it weren't for people like yourself willing to step up to take this on, our nation would be much poorer for having lost pieces of our heritage. This equipment will be very useful in shedding light on the unusual and remarkable smoke missions flown by Army Aviation in Vietnam. As you well know, this technology is little known and not much has been done previously to preserve it, yet, it had a significant impact on the tactical use of helicopters in those units that employed it. The ability to showcase it is greatly appreciated.
